The theatre audition will evaluate: Performance skills, Preparation, Energy/Presence, Acting instinct, Ability to take direction and critiques, Characterization/Understanding of the monologue, Physicality (gestures, posture, movement,) Vocal Expression (diction, projection, vocal quality,) and Professionalism.

Middle School

Students auditioning are required to:

- Bring a theatrical resume (if experienced.)
- Memorize and perform one 1-minute Contemporary Monologue from our monologue list. (To choose/download a required monologue script, click on Reference Documents and Monologues at the left of this page.)
- Students should come to the audition dressed in loose clothing, secure closed-toed shoes (no flip flops) and be able to move about freely.

High School

There are four different tracks for high school theatre majors:

Costume Design
Musical Theatre
Technical Theatre

Students auditioning for High School Theatre are required to:

- Bring a theatrical resume (if experienced.)
- Memorize and perform two 1-minute monologues chosen from our approved monologue List. (To choose/download a required monologue script, click on Reference Documents and Monologues at the left of this page.)
- One monologue should be Contemporary and one should be Shakespearean.
- Students should come to the audition dressed in loose clothing, secure closed-toed shoes (no flip flops,) and be able to move about freely.
